TREASURER'S REPORT  
AUGUST 12, 2024

**Regular Meeting, Monday, August 12, 2024**

The regular meeting of the Village of Elbridge Board of Trustees was called to order at 7:00 p.m. in the Municipal Offices, 210 West Main Street. Trustees present were Trustee Ellingworth and Trustee Harris with Deputy Mayor DeMarco presiding.

Mayor DeCola were absent.

Also present were Budget Officer Fred Weisskopf, Fire Chief Ryan Peters and residents Mr. Horner and Mr. Zankowski.

Deputy Mayor DeMarco led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Deputy Mayor DeMarco recognized Mr. Zankowski who asked for an update on Willow Lane brush and ditch cleanout. He an Mr. Horner expressed concern with the drainage, especially since paving took place. Mr. Horner has issues surrounding a tree that had never been a problem before. Discussion and request for DPW to clean out Willow Lane drainage issue areas. Drainage discussion re: Athens to Sandbank. Both gentlemen brought to attention of the Board that the 30-mph sign is still missing from Crossett Road as well as the Village of Elbridge sign. Discussion.

Both residents left the meeting at 7:26 p.m.

A motion was offered by Trustee Ellingworth, seconded by Trustee Ely, and carried to forgo the reading of the minutes from the last regular meeting on July 1, 2024.

The minutes of the last regular meeting on July 1, 2023 were accepted on a motion made by Trustee Ely, seconded by Trustee Ellingworth and carried.

**Reports of Officers and Committees –**

There was no Treasurer's Report due to the Fiscal Year end and A.U.D. completion. Discussion on AUD Report and Reserve options.

There was no Code Enforcement report.

There was no Public Works Report.

Trustee Harris presented the Historian's Report for July who moved for its acceptance, seconded by Trustee DeMarco and carried.

Fire Chief Ryan Peters presented the Fire Department Report, Trustee Ely moved for its acceptance, seconded by Trustee Harris and carried.

Discussions between Board and FD Chief Peters re: car show, building needs, physicals complete (all passed), Town Report due September (Chief Peters will complete), Truck inspections complete.

Board discussions re: Brown Street. A few driveways need to be fixed, need to get quotes. Board looked at photos and can see how the grade of the road was raised.

Discussion re: Water meter changes, CHIPS update and utilization of funds, Joint Water Project and Bid update, Beautification Committee.

**Trustee, Mayor and Attorney Reports –**

Trustee Ellingworth – Historian Myrna Sullivan has asked for DPW assistance in moving a telescope that was donated. Town has the storage space, will ask DPW for assistance.

Trustee DeMarco – Nothing at this time.

Trustee Harris – Troopers – landscaping needs to be put in, Athens – more still needs to be done, four-corners – needs to be kept up and more than just weed whacking. Discussion.

Trustee Ely- Need to be sure to get quotes for larger job, DPW and Fire Department.

After review of the bills by the Board of Trustees a motion was offered by Trustee DeMarco, seconded by Trustee Ellingworth, and carried to approve payment of August Abstract #3, for \$66,591.83 General Fund Vouchers A421 – A454 Checks 15655-15688, and \$20,510.05 for Water Fund Vouchers F154-F168 Checks 5619-5628 and \$12,242.10 Joint Water System Vouchers H91-H93, Checks 291-293.

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The meeting was adjourned at 9:10 p.m. on a motion made by Trustee Ely, seconded by Trustee Ellingworth and carried.
