

If you have any questions please don't hesitate to get in touch with us.



GARBAGE/RECYCLABLES

Garbage is picked up by our contractor every Monday. Clear plastic bags are preferred, but not required. A village trash sticker must be attached to each bag. The stickers are available at the village office during regular hours, and Elbridge Tops and the Elbridge Free Library (see hours below). They are sold in lots of four for \$10.00. Bags without stickers will not be picked up. Trash stickers are available through the mail if you enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope with your check.

Elbridge Free Library - Hours: Monday 1:30-8:00, Tuesday 1:30-5:30, Wednesday 9:00-11:00 & 1:30-8:00 (Story hour 9:00-11:00), Thursday & Friday 1:30-5:30, Saturday Noon-4:00, closed Saturdays in the summer, closed Sundays.

Elbridge Tops – Hours: Monday through Sunday 8:00 am – 8:00 pm daily.

Buying and placing a sticker on NONRESIDENT trash is considered theft of services.

Recyclables are picked up with the regular garbage collection. Blue bins are available at the Village office. BINS ARE TO BE LEFT WITH PROPERTY WHEN MOVING. Newspapers can be left in brown paper bags with recyclables.

Brush (Max 3" diameter by 6-8' long) is picked up by the Village as time permits. No grass or leaves are accepted.

Two Onondaga County Solid Waste Facilities available to residents are: Rock Cut, 469-6971, off Route 481, and Ley Creek, 474-7086, on 7th North Street.

RESIDENTS PLEASE NOTE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES!

All containers used by the Village residents for disposal must not weigh over sixty (60) pounds when full.

No limbs of trees, logs, brush, leaves, lawn trimmings and construction material will be taken by the contractor.

All materials shall be placed at the road's edge, and all trash shall be in containers that are not over the weight limit and are in good condition in garbage bags.

In the event there is freezing weather, trash shall be properly wrapped or placed in plastic bags so as not to freeze in the containers.

All residents will adhere to the terms of this contract and bring their trash, papers, and rubbish to the road's edge adjacent to their property, whether public or private, in suitable containers, not to exceed six (6) containers per family unit for collection as already outlined.

Rubbish and recyclable pickups are to take place between six A.M. and three P.M. in an established uniform schedule on a week day.

Trash and or recyclable refuse not properly separated according to Village and County standards shall be left and the contractor shall notify the homeowner as to the reason their trash and or recyclables was not picked up.

Absolutely only trash with Village of Elbridge identification will be picked up and recyclables only in blue bins.

PROPERTY OWNERS IN THE VILLAGE OF ELBRIDGE

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT BUILDING AND ZONING PERMITS

The purpose of planning, zoning and code enforcement in the Village is to protect the community, to insure safe buildings and site conditions. Through your co-operation we do insure the continued well-being of the community.

REMEMBER, you need a permit for:

- 1) Any improvement, alteration, enlargement, removal, demolition, construction, erection, or any change in nature of use or occupancy, of any building or structure*;
- 2) Any earth filling, earth removal, excavation or grading, that changes the contour or grade of your property (including driveways);
- 3) Any addition to or extension of the electrical or plumbing system in an existing building or structure;

The above is a partial list of projects that require a zoning permit. If you are unsure whether or not a permit is needed, please call the Code Enforcement Officer at 689-6667.

*The words 'building' or "structure", as used above, includes decks, patios, storage sheds, swimming pools, fences, CB and satellite dish antennas.

Garage Sale permits are available at the office for a \$5.00 fee.

WATER BILLING

Water Billings are done quarterly, January 5th, April 5th, July 5th and October 5th. Rules and regulations are available at the village office. Bills are due on the fifth of the following month. Penalties are assessed monthly at 10% . If you are moving, be sure to call for a final inside meter reading. Repairs and damage are the financial responsibility of the homeowner.
